Applicants must successfully pass a written test, an aerobic capacity run, a physical assessment test, **SPECIAL NOTE:**

a background check, a polygraph examination, interview and medical / physical examination.

EDUCATION: High school diploma (or) GED Certificate (or) 12 semester hours from an accredited college or university.

RESIDENCY: Must live within thirty (30) minutes of designated report-in station; must be accomplished within six (6)

months of employment.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: 18 - 35 years of age (cannot have reached 36th birthday by date of certification).

LICENSE: Valid and current Class "C" drivers' license. (Will be required to obtain Class "B" while in training).

VETERAN: Must have received an Honorable Discharge to qualify for veteran points on passing score of 70.
